

Some/Any

-we use some in positive sentences

Eg: I am going to buy some clothes.

There is some ice in the fridge

-we use any in negative sentences

Eg: I am not going to buy any clothes

We didn't do any exercises

***some and any in questions:**

-In most questions we use any:

Is there any ice in the fridge ?

Do you need any help?

-We normally use some when we offer things

a- Would you like some coffee?

b- yes, please

-or when we ask for things

a-Can you lend me some money?

b-sure, how much do you need?

***Some and Any without a noun:**

I did not take any photographs but Ann took some (some= photographs)

You can have some coffee but I don't want any (any= any coffee)
